<p>University of Nis (UNI) has organized a session with representatives of local companies. The roundtable in a hybrid mode (online and face-to-face) was organized on 19<sup>th</sup> May 2021 and lasted from 12 h to 15 h in line with the previously prepared roundtable agenda.</p> <p>The participants of the roundtable were representatives of 9 institutions: Public water company Srbija Vode, Water supply company NAISUS, Apoteke Knjaževac, Telenor Srbija, Amicos, Zelena gradnja, University of Natural and Life Sciences (BOKU), Faculty of Civil Engineering and Architecture and Faculty of Electronic Engineering.</p> <p>At the meeting, participants were introduced with the main objectives of the INNOWAT project and tailored made courses. Milan Gocić explained to participants the structure and the</p>	

learning outcomes of the INNOWAT module.

After that, Michael Tritthart talked about the innovations in the water sector in Austria highlighting the necessity for the introduction of innovation in this sector. Slaviša Trajković introduced the EU Water Policy under the Water Framework Directive, while Milan Gocić presented EU best practices in the water sector. The topic of general discussion was implementation of EU Water Framework Directive in the water sector in Serbia.

Participants expressed the interest for new module and concluded that future INNOWATE students will have opportunity to work on water quality programme and in general in the civil engineering sector.

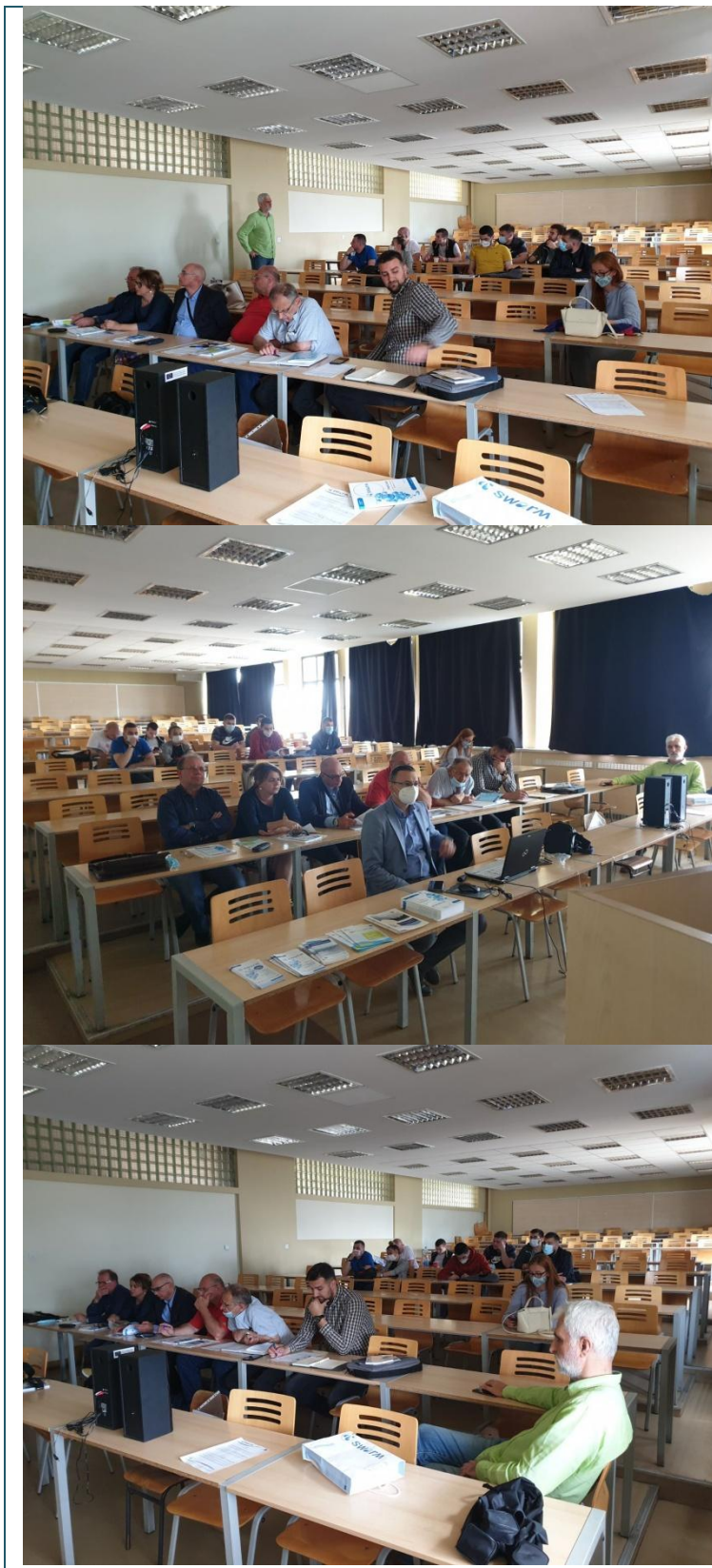

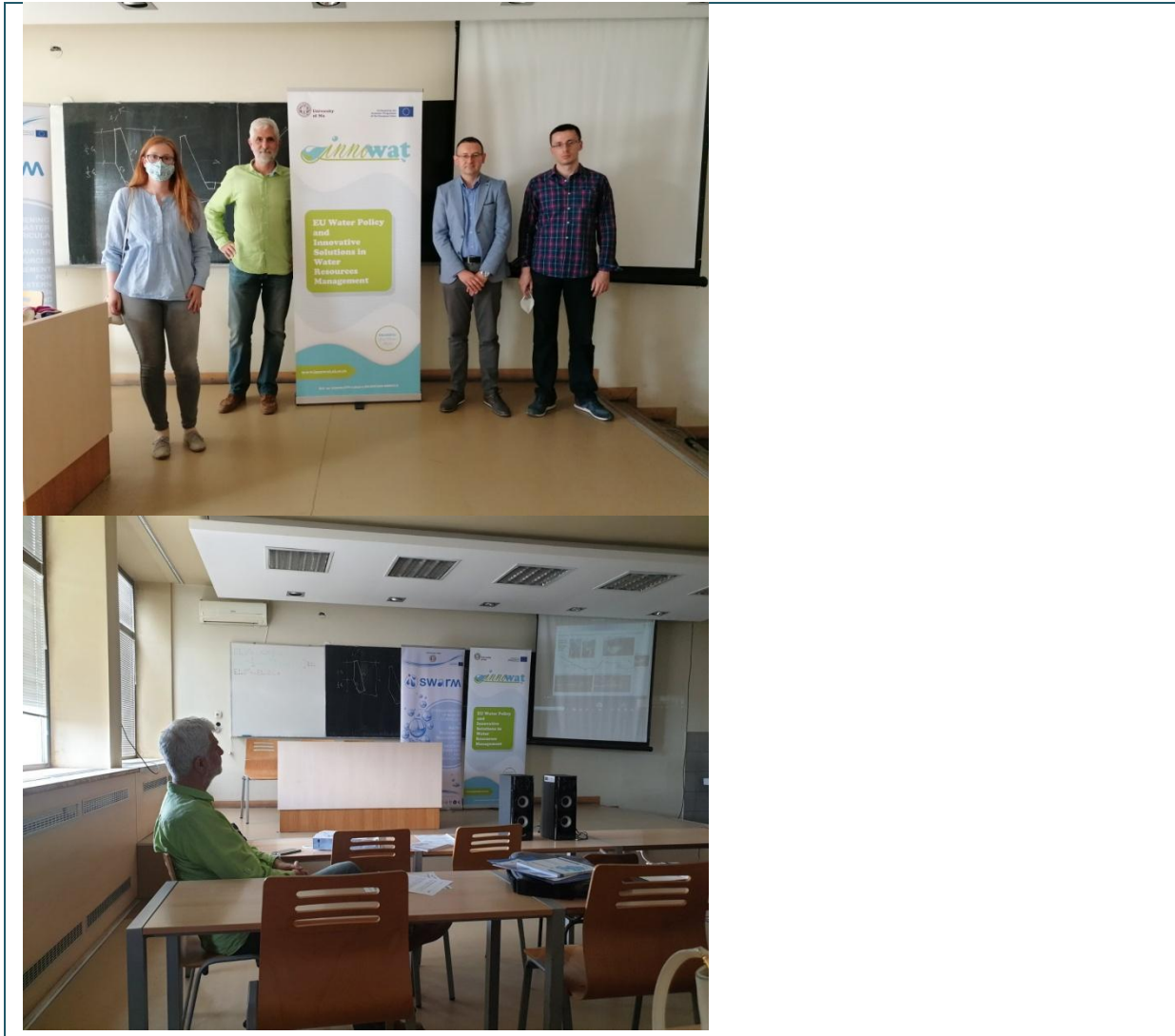
The roundtable finished at 15:00.

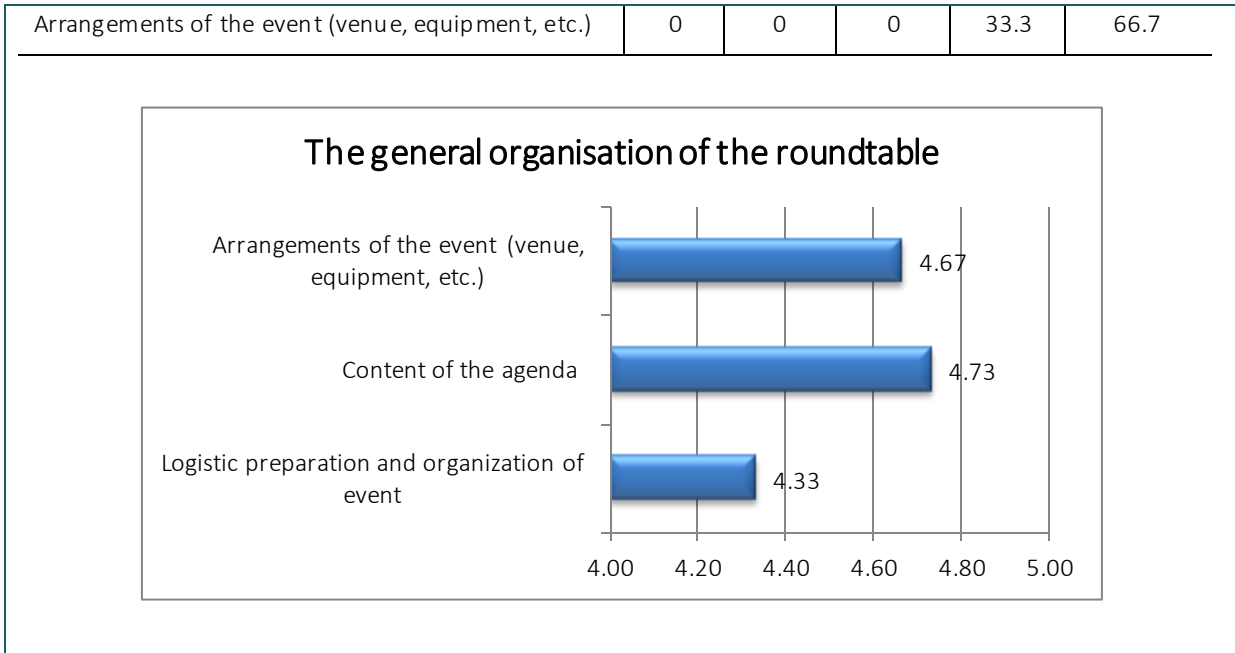

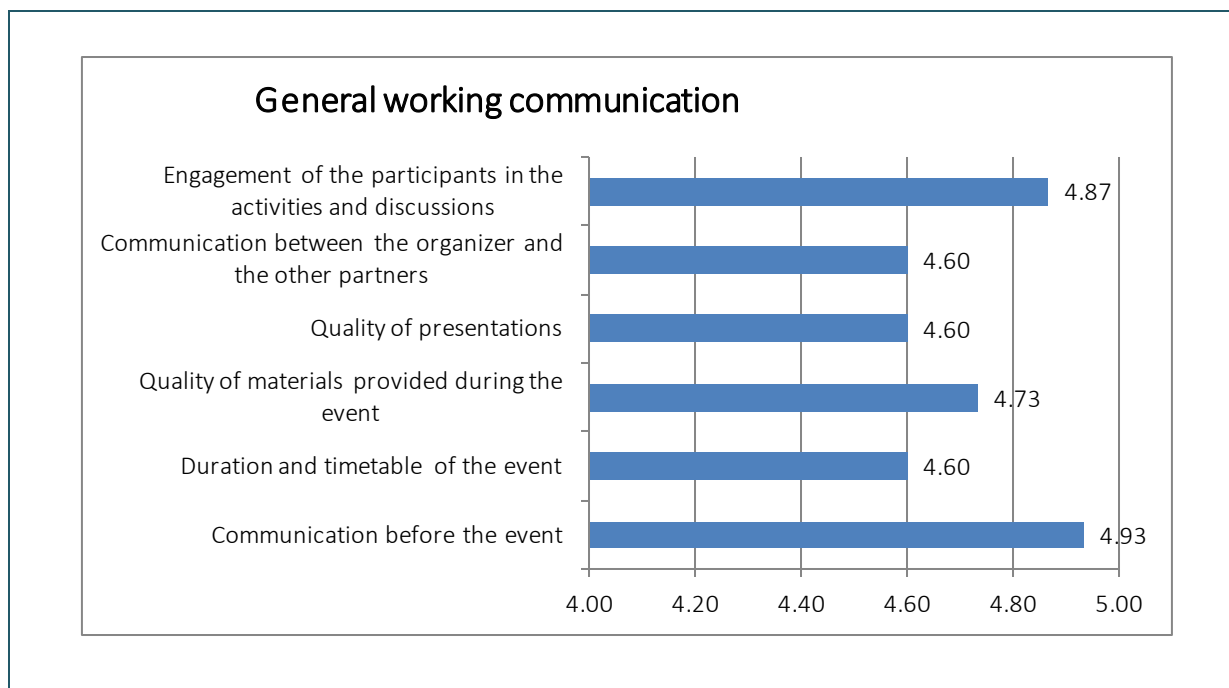

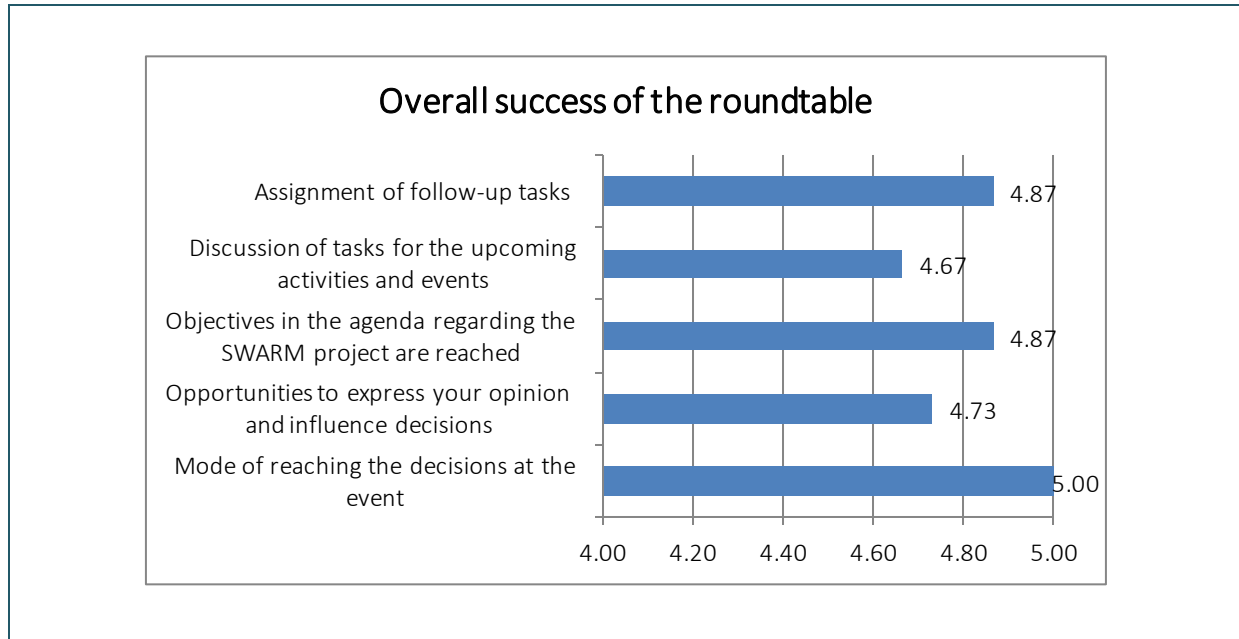
